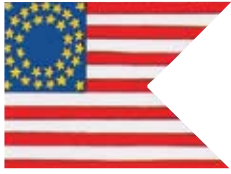

Confederate Flags

Are you a historical flag collector? Add these beautifully dyed 3'x5' (unless otherwise noted) historical reproductions of the Confederate Flags to your collection or give as a gift. Most flags are 100% nylon and are finished with a white canvas heading and brass grommets.

C.S.A. Jack "Battle Flag"...Confusion between the 1st National and the Stars and Stripes led to the making of this flag. The Battle Flag had a blue saltire (x shape) that held 13 stars for each of the Confederate states bordered with white over a red background. This flag now rectangular was originally square and was made in a variety of sizes out of a variety of materials.

1st National Flag...The first Confederate flag also known, as the **Stars and Bars Flag** was similar to the Stars and Stripes. Seven stars representing the number of Confederate states laid in a blue canton in the upper left corner with three broad red and white bars running horizontally. Confusion between the two flags led to a change to the Confederate flag.



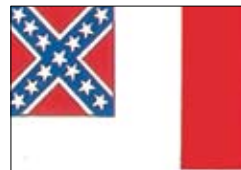

2nd National Flag...The second Confederate flag was found not to be ideal because when it wrapped around a staff only a white field, the sign for surrender, was left showing. This flag is also known as the Stainless Banner Flag.

3rd National Flag...For the last several months of the Civil War a red vertical stripe was added to the fly end of the Confederate Flag. This flag was the Confederate's third and final flag and flew until General Robert E. Lee surrendered in April of 1865.

The Bonnie Blue Flag...The first unofficial flag of the confederacy from the early 1800's.

Did You Know...

The second national Confederate flag was flown for only a brief period of time. When it was flown and wrapped around it's pole in the wind it looked like a white surrender flag, therefore the third national was created with the red vertical stripe to end the confusion.
